



School Fees

To help budget for the upcoming school year, we have outlined some possible fees your school may charge. ASSIST students receive scholarships from their schools that cover tuition, room and board only. There may be additional fees for which you will be responsible for, and these fees vary by school. We advise you to budget US \$2000 for expenses during the school year for items similar to the list of examples below. Please ask your school if you are responsible for any of the fees listed below.

Many schools have these types of required fees/charges:

- Health services
- Technology fees
- Uniforms
- Transportation
- Activity Fee/Class trips
- Guardian/Quarantine fee

Charges specific to a boarding or day school:

- Boarding schools – room/key deposit, bookstore deposit
- Day Schools often have a lunch fee

Elective Costs (not required; optional and within your control):

- Intercession/Interim
- Athletic fees
- Various testing
- Course fees
- Yearbook
